

## CAPTAIN'S COVE, DELICIOUS SEAFOOD IN A LAGOONSIDE SETTING

With its captivating waterfront setting and delectable seafood and steaks, Captain's Cove is a Cancún favorite, proudly serving visitors and locals alike since 1986.

The freshest local and imported seafood is mesquite-grilled, sautéed in garlic butter, served in a variety of sauces, prepared to traditional Mexican or Yucatecan recipes or cooked to order.

Captain's Cove house specialties include the sumptuous Seafood Platter for two, Tikinxic, or Mayan-style grilled fish, a hearty seafood soup and the Captain's Shrimp Trio. The chefs are also masters of the art of cooking Caribbean lobster; customers can order it grilled or sautéed and the flavor is superb.

Other recommendations include the *boquinete* or hogfish, a local fish prized for its flavorful white meat; snapper, grouper, mahi-mahi and shrimp, all of which are served in a variety of tempting dishes. Salmon, tuna and Chilean sea bass are also popular choices and crab, clams, mussels and calamari also appear on the menu.

Captain's Cove is a Seafood and Steak Grill and meat lovers will find plenty to tempt them, starting with juicy Angus steaks and BBQ ribs.

Diners looking for a lighter meal can order a variety of starters to share ranging from golden-fried calamari, traditional shrimp and fish tacos, ceviche or Thai shrimp or opt for clam chowder and a seared tuna salad.

The famous Captain's Cove Sunday Brunch is a popular weekend option for visitors and Cancún residents and is served from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. A Business Lunch special is available during the week from 12 noon to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Saturday and 2 to 4:30 p.m. on Sundays. A Prime Rib Night is also offered on Wednesdays and Saturdays.

With its tropical-style decor, wooden decks, cascades, luxuriant interior gardens, floor to ceiling windows, and romantic ambiance, Captain's Cove is waterfront dining at its

best. Diners can choose a table in the air-conditioned restaurant or enjoy their meal outside on the terrace. The views of the Nichupte Lagoon are spectacular; the restaurant has front row seats for sunset watching during Happy Hour and for stargazing later in the evening. Diners often catch a glimpse of white egrets, great blue and green herons, fish jumping and the lagoon crocodiles that make late night visits to the restaurant in the hope of receiving tasty morsels.

After dinner, the fun continues next door to Pancho & Willy's Bar, where the entertainment line up features music videos and karaoke starting at 9 p.m. on different nights of the week. There is a Mexican Night on Monday with a traditional buffet and live show. Sunset Happy Hour is from 4 to 6 p.m., snacks are available and there is a dance floor in the bar.

Pancho & Willy's owes its name to two crocodiles that visited Captain's Cove on a regular basis for many years. The waiters called them Pancho and Willy and decided that there was no better way to pay tribute to them than christening the bar in their honor!

Captain's Cove is an ideal setting for special events such as family reunions, anniversary dinners and sunset weddings on the deck. Dinner in the restaurant can be followed by live music and dancing at Pancho & Willy's. In fact, the bar has become a popular location for convention events, receptions and parties.

Captain's Cove is open daily from noon to 11 p.m. and Pancho and Willy's from 4 p.m. till... The restaurant is located on the shores of the lagoon, opposite the Cancún Maya Museum, Blvd. Kukulcán km 16.5, Hotel Zone.
