LA PALAPA

The first Royal restaurant, La Palapa at The Royal Cancun[®] is a Caribbean classic with an enchanting beachfront setting, tropical ambiance and spectacular views of the bay. EL CONQUISTADOR

Located at The Royal Islander, El Conquistador is famous for its gourmet cuisine, attentive service and intimate ambiance. Located in The Royal Islander[®], Cayo Largo permits guests to choose from one of two dining experiences. The enclosed lower level gives diners a welcome air-conditioned break from the tropical sun and the terrace offers spectacular ocean views. Cayo Largo is open daily from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. The lunch menu features a variety of soups, salads and sandwiches. Diners can savor the freshest Caribbean and Gulf of Mexico seafood cooked in a variety of ways for dinner. There is a garden bar for cocktails.

PACO'S TACOS

CAPTAIN'S COVE

This Cancún classic has been delighting diners since 1986 with its seafood menu, lagoonside location and Caribbean ambiance. The freshest local and imported seafood available is grilled, prepared to taste or cooked according to traditional Yucatecan and Mexican recipes. The menu also features Angus steaks, chicken, salads and more.

Captain's Cove is famous for its Sunday brunch and Prime Rib Night on Wednesdays and Saturdays keeps meat lovers happy.

Diners enjoy their meals in air-conditioned dining areas or al fresco under the stars on the waterfront deck. After dinner they can step next door to the bar. Called Pancho's & Willy's in honor of two of the crocodiles that are regular nightly visitors to Captain's Cove, the bar is the perfect place for cocktails and sunset watching and offers live entertainment during the week. Monday night is Mexican Night and there is a Mexican buffet, open bar folk dance show followed by karaoke. There is more karaoke on Wednesday and Friday nights from 9 p.m.
