



THE ROYAL CANCUN®

Nestled on one of Cancún's most beautiful bayside beaches with spectacular views of turquoise waters, The Royal Cancun® is a captivating Mexican Caribbean all-inclusive getaway, as perfect for a relaxing break with friends as it is for a family vacation. Located at km 4.5 on Kukulcán Boulevard, it is a five to 10-minute drive from the Hotel Zone's shopping malls, nightclubs and golf courses, 10 minutes to additional shopping and dining options in downtown Cancún and 20 minutes from the airport.

For a relaxing vacation, the REFINE All-Inclusive package at The Royal Cancun features dining, activities, use of the gym and much more.

Dotted with thatched shade umbrellas or *palapas*, the beach has soft white sand that is always cool to the touch and invites guests to spend hours sunbathing, playing beach games and even building sand castles with the children. The bay is shallow and waves are gentle, making it ideal for swimming, snorkeling and sail boating. Guests can sign up for complimentary sail boating and lessons are available on request.

With its white, low-rise buildings, red tiles, terraces and covered walkways, The Royal Cancun evokes traditional Mexican and Mediterranean villages. It is nestled in impeccably kept gardens featuring cascades of deep-hued bougainvillea, hibiscus and other tropical flowering shrubs and several species of graceful palm trees. There's even a rose garden with a fountain, which is a popular spot for reading and reflection.

The Royal Cancun was the first of the Royal Resorts® luxury vacation ownership properties to be built and it is also one of Cancún's pioneer resorts. Construction began in 1977 and upon its inauguration in 1978 it fast became the industry benchmark by which all other resorts were measured.

Each of the 201 fully furnished two-bedroom suites has a spacious private, open-air terrace, a kitchen equipped with everything guests could need for vacation cooking, and a comfortable living and dining area. Other amenities include complimentary Wi-Fi, flat screen TV, DVD player, a sound system and central air conditioning. Suites come in two sizes: two-bedroom, two-bathroom master suites with 1,400 square feet of space sleeping





up to six guests and two-bedroom, one-bathroom units (900 square feet) sleeping up to five people. Some suites have beach and ocean views or look out over the pools, gardens or the Nichupte Lagoon.

With its laidback tropical ambiance, fresh seafood and tasty Mexican and international cuisine, friendly staff and breathtaking beach views, La Palapa is a longtime favorite for breakfast, lunch and dinner. La Trattoria serves up traditional Italian dishes for lunch and dinner. Themed dinners are also staged during the week and include Lobster Night, Taco Night and a Caribbean Beach Party. Guests who prefer a casual dinner on their villa terrace can also order a selection of family supper dishes and pizzas from the food to go menu offered by the restaurant.

Guests at The Royal Cancun relax on the beach, cool off in the two-freeform pools and enjoy a wide range of resort facilities, including swim up pool bars and a lobby bar, a fitness center, a mini villa spa offering facials, massages, manicures and pedicures (fees apply), a kids club, kids play area and tennis courts with floodlighting for night play. They can sign out tennis rackets, snorkeling gear, bikes, golf clubs and sailboats from the sports desk and join in the daily activities for adults, teenagers and smaller children organized by the Social Activities staff. Options include beach and pool games, craft activities and board games.

The resort also has a well-stocked convenience store, a guest laundry, car rental and a travel desk for organizing day trips to the area's famous Mayan sites, eco parks, cruises, dolphin swims, snorkeling, diving and fishing charters and much more.

An inter-resort shuttle runs at intervals during the day linking The Royal Cancun to its sister resorts. This enables guests to take advantage of many additional services such as a larger, full-service Spa at The Royal Sands, a variety of restaurants, bars, gift shops, activities and water sports.

In 2014, members of the worldwide Trip Advisor travel community honored The Royal Cancun with a Trip Advisor Traveler's Choice award in the Best Family Resort category.

The Royal Cancun is certified by MARTI (Mesoamerican Reef Tourism Initiative) as a resort with eco-friendly policies and in 2013, it received the





Distintivo S from the Mexican Tourism Board, a distinction awarded to resorts for their work towards sustainability.
