



## THE ROYAL CARIBBEAN®

Lounging at the edge of oversize freshwater pools, engaging in an energetic set or two of tennis or strolling along one of Cancún's loveliest beaches are all part of The Royal Caribbean® vacation experience. A Royal Resorts® vacation ownership property, The Royal Caribbean is a deluxe private club set directly on the beach, with unparalleled views of white sands, the turquoise waters of the Caribbean and of the Nichupte Lagoon.

All 207 two-bedroom master suites have an area of more than 1,400 square feet, with tasteful furnishings and amenities such as Wi-Fi, flat screen TV, DVD and a sound system for a relaxing and enjoyable stay. The living-dining area is comfortable and has two pull-down Murphy beds and there are two bathrooms. A fully equipped kitchen invites guests to prepare a meal and enjoy it with cocktails on the spacious private terrace overlooking the Caribbean. If guests prefer not to cook, they can order from a menu of home-style dinner items, salads, breads and desserts at the food-to-go counter in the resort restaurant called Tradewinds Express.

The master suites sleep up to six people and the innovative Royal Resorts flexivilla design enables the unit to be subdivided into a fully equipped one-bedroom suite for four people and a lock off hotel room for two. Both have an independent entrance, an en suite bathroom and ample closets. The lock off room also has a TV, coffee maker, microwave oven and mini fridge.

For resort dining, Tradewinds restaurant offers International favorites and Italian specialties and theme nights during the week. Next door, sister resort The Royal Islander® offers three more restaurants El Conquistador, Cayo Largo and Paco's Tacos, all within walking distance. Back at The Royal Caribbean, La Cabaña Bar is the spot for after-dinner drinks, and the weekly entertainment line up includes karaoke.

Services available at The Royal Caribbean include complimentary resort-wide Wi-Fi access, tour and car rental desks, a convenience store, gift shop, gym, mini Spa, the Royal Roast Coffee Co., a beauty salon, a daily social activity program and a supervised kids club for children aged four to 12 years.





The gardens surrounding The Royal Caribbean and The Royal Islander, are worth exploring and a network of paths links the properties. Colorful flowering plants such as hibiscus, bougainvillea, allamanda, heliconia and bird of paradise are employed to splendid effect in the landscaping of the grounds.

The Royal Caribbean is located at km. 17 on Kukulcan Boulevard in Cancun Hotel Zone and is behind the Cancún Maya Museum and the San Miguelito archaeological site. The nearest golf course is the Iberostar Cancun and for shoppers Kukulcan Plaza and La Isla Shopping Village are a ten-minute drive away. An inter-resort shuttle links The Royal Caribbean with the other Royal Resorts; the service is complimentary and runs during the day with departures at regular intervals from the resort motor lobby (reservations required).
