



THE ROYAL SANDS®

The Royal Sands® offers 340 two-bedroom master suites and an impressive array of resort amenities and activities on one of Cancún's finest beaches. The fourth resort in the Royal Resorts® vacation ownership group, The Royal Sands is located near Kukulcan Plaza and a short drive from its sister clubs.

Spacious and perfect for families or friends, the fully appointed master suites at this five-star resort have two bedrooms, two bathrooms, a well equipped kitchen, a living and dining area, walk-in closets, central air-conditioning and a spacious terrace with a spectacular view of the Caribbean. Accessible from the living room and the master bedroom, the terrace has a table set for four and a smaller drinks table with two chairs outside the bedroom. The second bedroom also has a balcony with chairs and a table for two.

Tastefully decorated in shades of green and pastel with tropical motifs, the master suites sleep up to six people (there are two pull down Murphy beds in the living room) and have telephones, safe, TV, DVD, CD players and complimentary Wi-Fi access. Maids clean them on a daily basis, keeping them spotless. Each maid is assigned the same five units every week and frequent visitors get used to seeing the same friendly face year after year.

The two-bedroom master suites have a total area of 1,448 square feet (134 m²), with the interior accounting for 1,216 square feet (113 m²) and the terrace and balcony 232 square feet (134 m²). The innovative Royal Resorts flexivilla design enables them to be subdivided into a fully equipped one-bedroom suite for four people and a lock off hotel room for two. Both have an independent entrance, an en suite bathroom and ample closets. The lock off room also has a TV, coffee maker, microwave oven and mini fridge.

For a relaxing all-inclusive vacation, the REFINE All-Inclusive package at The Royal Sands features dining, activities, use of the gym and kids club and much more.

Resort services include freshwater pools for adults and children, floodlit tennis courts, a lagoon-side marina, water sports center and tour desk. A busy social activities program





with options for children, teenagers and adults, makes the resort ideal for families and there is a supervised kids club for children aged between four and 12 years. Other amenities include a well-stocked convenience store, coffee shop, gift shop, jewelry store, car rental and the Sidelines Sports Bar. There is complimentary Wi-Fi access throughout the resort and Internet is also available in the convenience store for a fee for guests who did not bring their laptop.

Dining options include Hacienda Sisal for Mexican cuisine in a traditional hacienda setting, and La Veranda for international favorites. The poolside Char Hut serves lunch and snacks and for casual room dining, the Sands Express Food to Go counter and Bartolo's Pizza delivery service fit the bill.

A world-class Spa offers members and guests a range of massages, facial, body and anti-aging treatments, a fitness center and a beauty salon.

The Royal Sands is located at km 13.5 on the Kukulcan Boulevard in Cancún Hotel Zone. The nearest golf course is the Iberostar Cancun, and for shoppers Kukulcan Plaza and La Isla are within walking distance. An inter-resort shuttle links The Royal Sands with the other Royal Resorts; the service is complimentary and runs during the day with departures at regular intervals from the resort motor lobbies.

During the summer, families staying at the resort may be lucky enough to catch a glimpse of a sea turtle laying its eggs on the beach in front of the resort at night or help staff release a baby turtle. The Royal Sands participates in the sea turtle protection campaign that takes place throughout the Mexican Caribbean every year.

From recycling to beach cleaning, energy efficient lighting and solar panels to heat water, many eco-friendly initiatives have been implemented at The Royal Sands. It is certified by the Mesoamerican Reef Tourism Initiative (MARTI) for its green program and was awarded the Distintivo S by the Mexican Tourism Board in 2013 for its commitment to sustainability.
